Shade: Plants that do well or prefer a shady environment may be categorized as "full shade," "low light," or "north exposure."

Moderate moisture

- Variegated ivy

High moisture

*Note: Heat and UVB lamps are not sufficient for photosynthesis, you will need a low level grow light for 4-6 hours/day.

Moderate Light: These are plants likely to be categorized as "part shade," "indirect sunlight," or "east/west exposure."

Bright Light: Plants that do well in a bright light environment are likely to be categorized as, "part/full sun," "direct sun," or "south exposure."

Low moisture

- Elephant feed
- Prickly Pear
- Sempervivum

High moisture

- Gardenia
- Pitcher plant

*Note: Keep in mind that not all full-sun plants are heat-tolerant.
