

SHADE PLANTS



Working with low light plants

Plants that do well or prefer a shady environment may be categorized as "full shade," "low light," or "north exposure."

Heat and UVB lamps are not enough to provide the light levels needed for photosynthesis, you will need a low level grow light for 4-6 hours/day.



Moderate Moisture Required

- Variegated ivy
- Pothos
- Spider plant
- Heart leaf philodendron
- Cast iron plant



High Moisture Required

- Creeping fig
- Selaginella
- Sweetheart ivy
- Calathea
